To strengthen the traceability system for Mexican meat, the <u>Agreement</u> was published in which Senasica is delegated the powers to verify, inspect, monitor and enforce the Mexican Official Standard <u>NOM-001-SAG/GAN-2015</u>, in terms of sanitary control, traceability and traceability of cattle and beehives, as well as the administration, operation and use of computer systems, which brings with it a reengineering for the strengthening of SINIIGA and the Computer System for Traceability of Agricultural, Aquaculture and Fishing Goods (SITMA, by its Spanish acronym).

In this regard, the Ministry of Agriculture, Senasica, Amsda and the National Confederation of Livestock Organizations (CNOG, by its Spanish acronym) installed the National Steering Council (CDN, by its Spanish acronym) of the National Individual Livestock Identification and Animal Identification Systems (SINIIGA-SINIDA, by its Spanish acronym). The scheme integrates the operation of the Animal Identification System, the National Livestock Register (PGN, by its Spanish acronym) and the Electronic Register of Mobilization (REEMO, by its Spanish acronym), which are under the stewardship of the federal government and operated by CNOG.
