

UCON, Animal health quality password for reliable import users

National Service of Agrifood Health, Safety and Quality | November 15, 2020



The UCON password is free of charge and is granted to reliable import users, who are recognized as having acted with responsibility and commitment in the import of goods of animal origin, complying with health and safety standards to protect the agricultural heritage and the health of consumers.

Importers that send their meat imports to a Federal Inspection Type (TIF, by its Spanish acronym) establishment for processing, where the Official Veterinarian, Authorized Responsible Veterinarian or Authorized Third Party Specialist will verify and inspect the meat, carcasses, viscera and offal in accordance with the procedure established in [NOM-030-ZOO-1995](#), will be subject to obtain the UCON animal health quality password.

By obtaining the password, inspection time at the point of entry is reduced and the release of import shipments is expedited. This generates confidence in the sanitary authority, prestige for the Reliable User and security for its clients, at the same time, the traceability of the merchandise is maintained, this way the health and innocuousness of the product is favored.
